Step 1: Open the collage maker and tap on "Background."



Step 2: Tap on the background you'd like to use. If you don't have the Meme Backgrounds pack, you can download it for free from the PicsArt Shop.



Step 3: Select the picture you'd like to use and tap on "Add."



Step 4: Tap on the Cutout icon.



Step 5: Use your finger or stylus to roughly outline the portion of your picture you'd like to crop. Tap on the arrow icon.



Step 6: Your selection will appear as a preview. Tap on the eye icon to view your selection along with the rest of your picture.

Step 7: Tap on the paintbrush icon and refine your selection. When you're done, tap on "Save." Your selection will automatically be saved in the "My Stickers" section of the sticker menu.



Step 8: Drag the arrow icon to enlarge your picture and place it on your background.



Step 9: Tap on the plus sign and select "Text."



Step 10: Type the first line of your text and tap on the check mark.



Step 11: Select your font from the fonts menu. We used a font from the default PicsArt Fonts pack, but if you'd like to view a different package, tap on the arrow icon on the left side.



Step 12: Enlarge the text and place it on your background. Drag the edges of the text box if you'd like to adjust the dimensions.

Step 13: Tap on the Stroke icon.



Step 14: Select "Color."



Step 15: The color black will be selected automatically. If you'd like to use a different color, select one from the menu. Tap on "Thickness."



Step 16: Use the slider to adjust the thickness of your text outline. When you're done, tap on the plus sign and select "Text."



Step 17: Repeat the process to add a second line to your meme. When you're done, tap on "Apply."



Step 18: Tap on the arrow icon to finish. Save your picture and share it on PicsArt with the hashtag #FunnyMeme!
