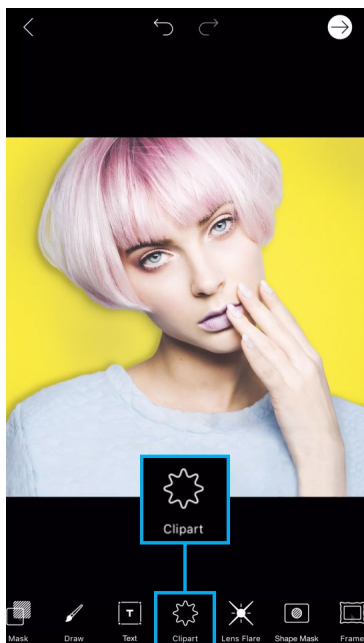
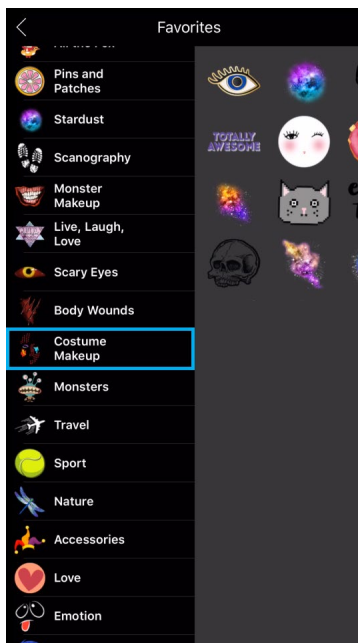

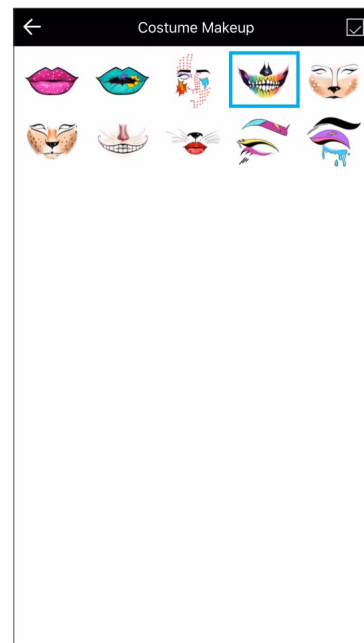
Halloween Makeup



Step 1: Open a portrait in the photo editor. Use one of your own pictures, or find one by another user by searching for #FreeToEdit and #Portrait in the app. Tap on the Clipart icon.



Step 2: Open the Costume Makeup pack.



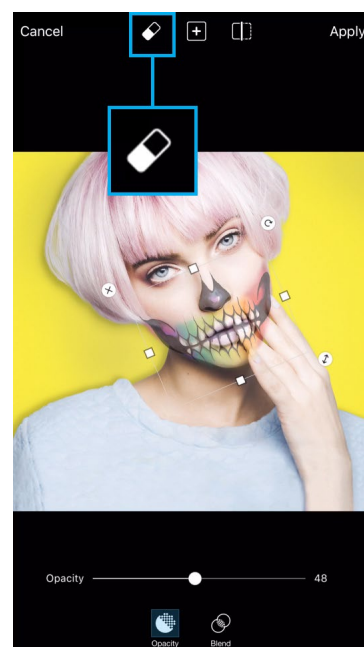
Step 3: Tap on the Clipart you'd like to use.



Step 4: Use the arrow icons to enlarge and rotate the Clipart and drag it to place it.



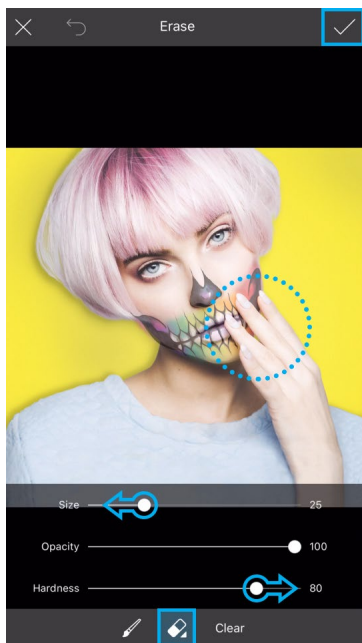
Step 5: Use the slider to reduce the opacity a bit.



Step 6: Tap on the eraser icon at the top of the screen.

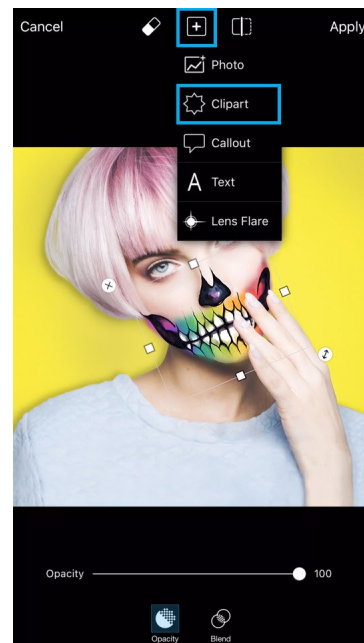

Step 7: Tap on the eraser in the bottom toolbar to open the brush settings menu. Use the sliders to adjust the hardness and size. Use your finger or stylus to erase the unnecessary parts of the Clipart. Tap on the check mark to confirm.



Step 8: Use the slider to bring the opacity back up to 100%.



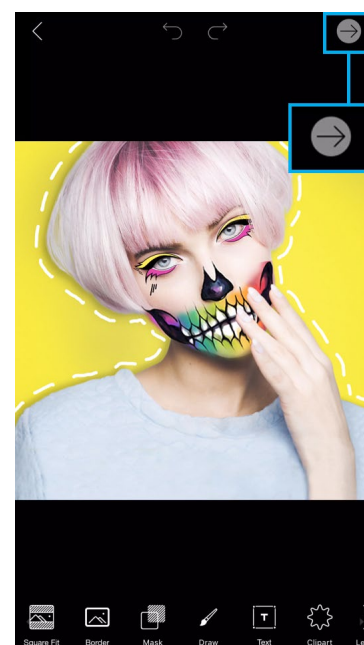
Step 9: Tap on the plus sign and select "Clipart." Repeat the process to add Clipart makeup over the eyes.



Step 10: When you're done, tap on "Apply."
